Dues and Race Entry Fees - 2010

Dues

- **Competitive Member** - includes USACK membership for 2009 calendar year \$75.00 (on-line Registration)
 - **\$80 at an event**
- **Family Members** - includes ACA membership for 2009 calendar year \$175.00 - (2 adults + 2 juniors - must join at the same time)
- **Junior Member** – Middle or High School Student, includes ACA membership \$40.00
- **Associate Member** - Non-racing membership \$30.00

Entry Fees

- **Adult Entry Fee per Race (H.I.P.A. Member) \$20.00**
- **Adult Entry Fee per Race (Non H.I.P.A. Member) \$30.00** (Includes single day ACA insurance)
If you plan on competing in 5 or less events in all of calendar year 2009, you will pay less by the race.
- **Junior (15-20) Racing on Short or Long Course \$10.00**
- **Juniors in junior race** – (H.I.P.A. Members) \$0 - must sign race day waiver.
- **Juniors in junior race** – (NON-H.I.P.A. members) \$10

What you get for what you pay.

- Membership of Hawai'i Island Paddlesports Association and participation in all H.I.P.A. Events in 2010.
- Membership in USA Canoe and Kayak National Association.
- Liability Insurance coverage for all H.I.P.A. events for the 2010 calendar year.
- H.I.P.A. Member Shirt for 2010.

- Liability Insurance \$50 per paddler (from your dues).
- Administrative Expenses.
- Professional Fees (CPA).
- Safety Equipment and radios.
- Equipment Storage
- Computers and timing equipment.
- Website and Phone

What do the entry Fee Pay for?

- Awards
- Lunch
- Safety / Escort Boats
- Non Member Entry fee pays for above and 1-day insurance.
- Admin. Expenses – paperwork, etc.
- Ice and other paddler items.
